The National Equestrian Centre is a busy Equestrian Centre in sunny, beautiful Canberra, Australia's Capital, which teaches vaulting as well as the Olympic disciplines of dressage, showjumping, cross country. It is one of the leading vaulting groups in Australia which has brought vaulters to Germany several times, has had numerous vaulters attend CVI's and WEGs in Europe and has had a Squad compete at WEG, Kentucky in 2010. School holiday programs are run during the holidays for riders and also for vaulters and there are active competition teams in both vaulting and riding. The Centre has an indoor arena and 2 outdoor arenas located on 750 hectares of land, very close to Canberra, only a few minutes from the centre of the city. There is a sizeable area dedicated to vaulting for barrel work with 7 barrels and other gym equipment.

At the Centre, there are 60 horses, 7 of whom are vaulting horses, and 5 donkeys. There are cattle and sheep grazing on the farm where the Equestrian Centre is located with wild kangaroos, wombats, possums, many wild parrots and other birds to be seen. The Aussie experience, will be a very rural one and lots of fun.

**The vaulting term** coincides with the school terms which enables travel and sightseeing during the school holidays.

It would be very beneficial to have a drivers licence.

If you are a vaulter, it is possible also for you to **vault and compete**, if you wish to do so. Accommodation will be provided with ensuite facilities heating and airconditioning, with a small kitchenette and lounge area.
